BUILDING INFORMATION



The Koffler Gallery/Koffler Centre of the Arts is located at Artscape Youngplace, 180 Shaw Street, Suite 104-105.

Artscape Youngplace is fully accessible by Ontario standards, with a wheelchair ramp at 180 Shaw Street doors, an elevator servicing every floor and a fully accessible washroom on every level. The nearby 63 Ossington bus on the TTC is wheelchair accessible.

School bus parking is available, but requires a minimum of 2 weeks notice.

Food and drink is available for purchase at the Two Penny Cafe, located in the building mezzanine across the hall from the Koffler Gallery. There is also seating available in the building for eating packed lunches or outside food. Picnic benches for outdoor eating can be found down the street at Trinity Bellwoods Park.
